Dear Jim,

I just wanted to thank you for agreeing to help me with my Eye Exams for Service Dogs event. As we discussed I will schedule a day where area service dogs, seeing eye, search and rescue, etc. will come into my clinic and receive a free ocular exam similar to what your ophthalmologist would do for you.

I anticipate the majority of the dogs will be normal but what if we find an ocular problem before it becomes clinically apparent? If we find a problem early then it may be resolved and the dog never has to leave service. I am especially appreciative of your willingness to work with the dog's primary veterinary care provider to obtain blood work and provide a Pet Wellness Report. Again, we may discover a sub clinical disease through the blood work and your Pet Wellness Report and correct the problem before it hampers the animal's service. I will have the owner schedule an appointment with me for the ocular examination. I would record who their primary care veterinarian and forward that information to you. In turn you would contact those veterinarians and arrange for the blood work to be performed and a Pet Wellness Report completed.

I believe this is an opportunity to give back to a group of animals in our community that have been serving us for years. Your thoughts regarding sponsorship of these events is a good one and please discuss it with the animal health companies participating in your programs. I look forward to hearing from you in the near future.
